**Consider quotes from various authorities on wind energy:**

**James Henslin** stated in his book, **Sociology: A Down To Earth Approach**, "Propaganda should be subtle, with the audience remaining unaware just which part of their mind or emotions is being manipulated. If propaganda is effective, people will not know why they support something, only that they do."

\* **The United States Energy Information Administration (EIA** - the U.S. Government's Official Source for Energy Statistics) states in their 2006 Annual Energy Outlook Report, that wind provided less than 4/10 of 1% total nationwide generation in 2005, and due to "considerable uncertainties", **might provide 1.1% by 2030!** 25 years and billions of our tax dollars later, we "might" get 1% nationwide generation from wind! **This is proof that wind can never live up to all their over-inflated claims!**

\* **Anne Humphrey, local woman gone corporate wind salesperson**, stated, "Horizon is in it for the long haul." Don't bet on it! Goldman Sachs has announced, "**HORIZON WIND IS FOR SALE!**"

\* **Attorney Daniel Spitzer**, when asked who would ultimately be responsible if the wind companies abandon the project at the Local Government Workshop in Mt. Morris on November 17, 2006, admitted, "**THE LAND OWNER WILL BE LIABLE!**"

\* **Tom Tanton, Senior Fellow with The Institute for Energy Research** in Lincoln, CA, for 36 years, said, "**Wind will not reduce global warming, or reduce pollution! There will not be a single coal plant that shuts down because of wind power development!** Our money would make a far greater difference in reducing pollution and global warming by putting the clean-coal technology that already exists in place at every coal plant worldwide."

\* **Richard Bolton, Engineer, Physicist, and President of the Environmental Compliance Alliance**, compiled data from Horizon's Maple Ridge Project at Tug Hill using their sales to the grid from July - Sept., 2006. Mr. Bolton stated, "Maple Ridge has a nameplate capacity of 240MW, but for 40% of the third quarter of 2006, the wind produced a paltry 30 MW or less, or no more than 12.5% of nameplate capacity. At no time during that three-month period did the output sustain the full 240 MW. Indeed, the wind turbines produce more than half the rated output only 15% of the time." Mr. Bolton's analysis goes on to conclude, "**The promise of 'green' power from industrial wind turbines is a sham.**" All their bogus sales pitches are based on 100% efficiency, 100% of the time.

\* **David Bassett, Department of Energy, Environmental Protection Agency, and U.S. Civil Aeronautics Board** stated, "A balanced energy future requires a balanced approach. **To propose building new electrical generating capacity in the face of existing and overwhelming inefficiency of current generation is fool-hardy and unwarranted!**"

\* **Environmentalist, Jon Boone**, said, "In the 5 years that I have been researching, writing and speaking on this issue, I could not substantiate a single claim developers made for industrial wind energy, including the one justifying its existence - that massive wind installations will somehow meaningfully reduce our reliance on fossil fuels. **Perhaps folks would be willing to sacrifice their quality of life on the altar of green energy if it actually worked!** The only environmentally responsible solution to the problem of our dependence upon fossil fuels must combine effective conservation with much higher efficiency standards - heavy lifting in deed, for the most wasteful culture in the history of the planet!"

**Former Attorney General, now Governor Eliot Spitzer**, as stated by the press release on his website, representing New York, along with 14 other states, "Sued the Department Of Energy For Failing Consumers On Energy Standards". The Department Of Energy has violated Congressionally enacted mandates to adopt stronger energy-saving standards for 22 common appliances that use large amounts of electricity, natural gas, and oil, which according to the government's own numbers, would generate substantial savings for consumers and reduce global warming emissions from power plants. **Based on the Department Of Energy's estimates, the average annual energy savings would meet the total annual energy needs of as many as 12 million American households. Annual electricity savings alone would approximately equal the output of up to 42 large power plants!**"

To date, the Department Of Energy has not responded. Neither has there been any further update from Governor Spitzer's office. Apparently, Governor Spitzer can't be bothered following through on a suit that **would actually act to conserve immense amounts of energy** both state, and nationwide, and according to the Government Accountability Office (GAO) **would save consumers 28 BILLION DOLLARS** nationwide in accumulated energy costs by 2030 if they had been enforced. \* **Former Vice-President, Al Gore**, has brought much attention to the issue of global warming of late with his documentary, "An Inconvenient Truth".
